- Dates: June 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 26, 27
- Times: 8:30 am to 4 pm (8:30 to 12:30 pm on 6/27)
- 3 Performances: June 27 and 28 at 6:30 pm, June 29 at 2 pm. Admission will be \$10. Admission will be required for everyone in the audience.
- Ages: Rising 4th through 9th graders, 16 years old or younger at camp time.
- Cost: \$400.00 per participant. \$350.00 each for two siblings. \$250.00 for tech crew.

All participants are expected to attend all sessions. Before registering, you must clear your child's schedule so they can attend each of our sessions fully. Preparing a show like this in seven and a half sessions is a huge undertaking. Allowing planned absences would not be fair to the cast or crew and would negatively impact the quality of our production. Additionally, participants must practice at home and learn dialogue/lyrics before our camp begins.

We will also have limited openings for stage crew and production team positions, which are great opportunities for older students. Stage/tech crew must attend our 2nd week and all shows. Attending our first week is optional for stage/tech crew.

Behavior:

This will be a very challenging program! Please be sure that your child can handle the demands involved in learning a full show in a short amount of time. All campers are expected to exhibit the absolute best in behavior and cooperative participation. Campers who prevent us from achieving our daily goals or distract others from doing their best will be sent home and no longer permitted to participate. Our participation fee is nonrefundable.

Registration:

Registration ends on May 19 or when we reach capacity, whichever occurs first. Once we reach capacity, we cannot accept any more students even if a completed registration form and or payment is submitted. Please only register your child after reading, understanding, and agreeing to the outlined details here.

Payment:

\$400.00 per performer. \$350.00 each for two siblings. \$250.00 for stage/tech crew. The fee must be paid by May 20. Your child will be registered once we receive payment, completed registration, and audition. No refunds. Payment will be made via Venmo (@PSBcreative), or checks can be mailed to PSBcreative, PO Box 443, Marietta, GA, 30061- 0443. This participation fee includes the instruction at all camp days, three performances, 1 t-shirt, and one student script.

Auditions:

Auditions to be in the cast of our upcoming musical will be on FlipGRID! All performers MUST submit a video audition by May 19. Auditions will consist of recording a video with introductions, acting, and singing. Casting will be announced on Saturday, May 25.

For an audition video, students MUST have the lines and lyrics memorized from the links below. Facial expression, voice inflection, and gestures will enhance their audition and are highly recommended. Our panel of judges will be looking for and rating (1-5) each student on the following: Singing, Spoken Diction, Stage Presence, Concentration, and Dance/Movement.

Any student who registers will be given a role in the show. For this reason, we encourage all students to tell us what other roles they might be interested in should they not be chosen for the role they auditioned for. The final casting will be announced on Saturday, May 25th.

ALL participants MUST submit an audition to be registered for camp.

- 1. Go to flipgrid.com or download the flipgrid app on the device you plan to record your audition with.
- 2. Enter the join code: 08b2d1b8
- 3. Click on the character you want to audition as (you may only audition for ONE character).
- 4. Read over the instructions to see what your video needs to include.

5. Record your audition and submit.

What to bring every day to camp:

- Your script (which we will provide). You are expected to come prepared with your lines and music, which you have learned well at home.

- Your best attitude and enough energy to actively and cooperatively participate throughout the day!
- Please label all your belongings.
